Mr. Thomas David Cory, 77 of Leesburg died September 30, 2013 at Magnolia Manor in Americus, GA.

A native of Litchfield, IL, Mr. Cory was a longtime resident of Albany where he was a member of the VFW and owned T&T Radio Electronics in the 1970's when CB Radios were popular. He served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Following his military service he went to work for Western Union in 1962 and retired from SAIC in 2004. Mr. Cory was very mechanically inclined. He loved to bass fish and tinker in his workshop.

Survivors include his sons, Mark David Cory and his wife Carol of Columbus, GA and Tracy Allen Cory of Leesburg, GA, grandchildren, Benjamin T. Cory, Sarah E. Cory, Rebecca D. Cory and Hannah M. Cory.
