Mr. Lawrence (Larry) Austin Drake, 83 of Moultrie, GA, former resident of Albany died November 6, 2013 at Magnolia Manor South in Moultrie. Funeral services will be Saturday 2 PM at First United Methodist Church Walden Chapel. Rev. Nancy Scarbrough officiating. Interment will follow in Crown Hill Cemetery.

A native of Hollywood, FL Mr. Drake lived most of his life in Florida and Georgia, where he served as Director of Christian Education in various Methodist churches. Mr. Drake served as a Senior Correctional Counselor at Lee Correctional Institution in Leesburg for 18 years. He was a member of First United Methodist Church, the United Methodist Men Sunday School class and a former member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. He graduated from South Broward High School and attended Florida Southern College in Lakeland, FL. He received his Associate of Arts degree from Darton College and his Master Degree in Christian Education from Emory University. Mr. Drake served in the United States Army.

Mr. Drake was preceded in death by his parents, Ruben Wood Drake and Flora Heath Drake, and his brother, Bobby L. Drake.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth Davis Drake of Moultrie, Niece, Cindy Hollingsworth, Nephews, Chuck and John Drake all of Huntsville, AL The family will receive friends 1 hour prior to the service at the Walden Chapel.
