James Lewis (Jimmy) Bacon, Jr. passed away on February 1 at the age of 93. Born in Albany, Georgia, on April 1, 1925, Mr. Bacon was the second child of James Lewis Bacon and Kate Mock Bacon. He was preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Cecile Bacon Slate.

Mr. Bacon was a graduate of Albany High School's Class of 1942. After graduation he enlisted in the United States Navy. He served during World War II as an Aviation Ordnanceman 1st Class, stationed mainly in the South Pacific, from 1942 to 1946. Upon completion of his Navy service, Mr. Bacon enrolled at St. Bernard College in Cullman, Alabama, where he graduated with a business degree in 1948.

Following initial employment with Westinghouse Electric, Mr. Bacon began a 36-year career in the cement industry. He retired in 1993 as territory manager for LaFarge of North America.

Mr. Bacon was a lifelong member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, where he was a member of the Knights of Columbus, served as an usher, and assisted in counting the weekly offering. He also cherished his decades-long fraternity with his fellow Elks as a member of Albany BPOE Lodge 713.

Mr. Bacon is survived by his wife of almost 68 years, Anita Pait Bacon, whom he married on February 3, 1951; his brother, Dr. William H. Bacon; his three children, Bernadette Bacon Kirkland and spouse Michael, James Lewis Bacon, III and spouse Gina, and Lacy Bacon Meier and spouse John; six grandchildren, Curt Hall (Jade), Michael Kirkland, Jr. (Kristine Norton), Andrew Kirkland, Jim Kirkland (Jessica), Ashley Meier Hatcher, and Mariel Meier Nelson (Billy); and two great-grandchildren, Hannah Hall and Pait Hatcher. The family is most appreciative of the support and affection given to Mr. Bacon in his last months by Gloria Hall.

A funeral Mass for Mr. Bacon will be held at St. Teresa's Catholic Church on February 4 at 10 AM. Visitation will follow the Mass in the church narthex. Private interment at Crown Hill Cemetery will follow at a later time. In lieu of flowers, the family requests that donations be made to St. Teresa's Catholic Church in Mr. Bacon's memory.
