Linda Lee Johnson Johnson, 80, of Albany, died Saturday, September 22, 2018 at her residence. Memorial services will be held Thursday, September 27, 2018 at 12:00 Noon at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at 11:00 AM at the Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church's parlor. Rev Robert Greene and Dr. Don Kea will officiate.

Linda graduated from Northside High School in Atlanta where she was selected as homecoming queen. Miss Johnson attended the University of Georgia where she was a member of the Chi Omega Sorority. While a student at the University of Georgia, Linda was a member of the Pandora Homecoming Court. After her marriage to Billups Johnson, Mrs. Johnson was also honored as the first Mrs. Homecoming at the Georgia Institute of Technology.

Mrs. Johnson was a member of the Athens Junior Assembly (now the Junior League of Athens). After moving to Albany, she served her community as a member of the Junior League of Albany and the Charity League of Albany. As a 55-year member of Porterfield United Methodist Church, Linda enjoyed her time as a member of the Covenant Bible Study Group. With gardening as a life-long passion, Mrs. Johnson was proud to be a founder of the Albany Serendipity Garden Club.

Linda Johnson's three children expressed the same sentiments, "Our mother throughout our lives surrounded us with grace and elegance in everything that she did. Our home was always a warm and welcoming place for all who entered. Everything about her and everything she touched was beautiful."

Prior to her death, Linda wrote, "I always wanted to be a wife and mother; God granted me both. My family was my life. I was very blessed."

Survivors include her husband, Billups P. Johnson, Jr., a son, Billups P. Johnson III "Bo" and his wife, Pam of Leesburg, GA, 2 daughters, Laura J. Weber and her husband, Trent, Ansley J. Cotton, Billups P. They, I think, could give teenage girls a run for their money for the time they spent chatting on the phone. What was always communicated to my mother from Linda (there, I said it) was dignity in friendship. Linda elevated those close to her. She made us laugh; she fed our souls; and, yes, she made us cry. She was worth our love and praise. She deserved it, and she deserves all the peace and comfort she now knows, in the Lord's hands.
