



Dr. A. M. Freeman, Jr. Obituary

December 1, 1926 - July 10, 2006

Dr. Atwood McGowan (Mack) Freeman, Jr. 79, of Tifton, formerly of Albany, died Monday, July 10, 2006 at his residence. His funeral service will be THURSDAY 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern. The interment service will be private. The Rev. Eric Sizemore will officiate. A native of Waycross, GA, Dr. Freeman was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Albany, the Albany Sports Hall of Fame, and the Albany Rotary Club. A practicing orthopedic surgeon for many years in Albany, then in Tifton, Dr. Freeman was a member of the Medical Association of Georgia, the American Medical Association, the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons, the American Foot and Ankle Society, the Pan American Medical Association, the Georgia Orthopedic Society, and the Dougherty County Medical Society. He was the President and co-founder of the Helping Hands Medical Mission. Dr. Freeman was a veteran of the US Army and an avid hunter and fisherman. He was preceded in death by his parents: Atwood McGowan Freeman, Sr. and Thelma Tomberlin Freeman, and a sister: Elizabeth Freeman Browning. Those surviving include his wife: Helen Freeman, Tifton; his children: Patricia Freeman, Alexandria, VA, Richard (Marty) Freeman and his wife Dottie, Tifton, Michael C. Freeman and his wife Jane, Lawrenceville, GA, Andrew Brett Freeman and his wife Terri, Leesburg, GA, Lani L. Freeman, Tifton; 9 grandchildren: Mack, Mason, Chandler, Christopher, Morgan, Ellen, Cameron, Baylee, and Emmalee Margaret.
