Mrs. Aileen Roberson, 99, of Lee County died Saturday September 29, 2018 at Magnolia Manor Nursing Center in Americus, GA.

A graveside funeral service will Tuesday 11:00AM at Crown Hill Cemetery.

The family will receive friends Monday from 5:00 to 7:00PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Amanda Aileen Johnson was born in Booneville, North Carolina on August 20, 1919 to Nan Key Johnson and Amie Johnson. She attended Yadkin County High School and Winston Salem College where she graduated with a degree in Accounting. After college, Aileen was employed as an Accountant for Indura Mills in Winston Salem. Aileen became engaged to Dr. Phil E.

Roberson in March, 1941, and they were married on April 10, 1943. Later that same year, the couple set up a medical practice on N. Slappey Blvd., where Aileen served as bookkeeper and office manager. Aileen was also trained and certified in the operation of the offices GE X-ray machine. The couple's first child, Aileen Elizabeth, was born on April 13, 1953. On June 29, 1956, Aileen gave birth to twins, Phillip Edmund and Canoy Estelle Roberson.

Over the years, Aileen was a member of several civic clubs in Albany, including the Women's Garden Club and the Ladies' Auxiliary. Aileen's hobbies also included performing landscape work and gardening at the family's Lee County Farm, which the couple purchased in 1944.

Aileen was preceded in death by her mother and father, her husband, ten of her eleven brothers and sisters, and her daughter, Canoy Estelle Roberson.

She is survived by her son, Phillip Edmund Roberson and his wife Debbie; her
