Alfred Charles Asmus, 64, of Warner Robins, GA, formerly of Lee County, died Monday, October 14, 2024 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

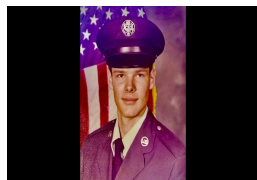
