Alice Cullen Chastain, 93, of Atlanta, died Saturday, March 21, 2009 at Calhoun Memorial Hospital, Arlington, GA. Her funeral service will be WEDNESDAY 11 AM at Felton Cemetery, Montezuma, GA. Dr. William H. "Bill" Buntin, Jr. will officiate. Miss Chastain was born in Montezuma, GA. Her parents were George M. Chastain, Sr. and Carrie Richardson Chastain. She graduated from Montezuma High School and from Wesleyan College in Macon, GA. She was employed with Lockheed Aeronautical and retired in 1978 from the Georgia Institute of Technology as an executive assistant to the Dean. She volunteered at Piedmont Hospital and with the Atlanta Historical Society. She was a member of Daughters of the American Revolution, the Colonial Dames, and the United Daughters of the Confederacy. Miss Chastain was a world traveler visiting England, other parts of Europe, Asia, Australia, and Africa. She was an avid supporter of Georgia Tech football and the national Democratic Party. She was preceded in death by her parents, brother, George M. Chastain, Jr. and a sister-in-law: Jessie Thomas Chastain. She is survived by her nephew: George M. Chastain, III, MD and his wife Sarah Anne, Albany; a niece: Anne Drake, Lake Charles, LA; great nephews: George M. Chastain, IV and his wife Susan, Ottawa, Canada, Scott M.
