Alice Edmonds Kirksey, 89, of Albany, died Tuesday, March 20, 2007. Her funeral service will be FRIDAY 12:00 PM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with Rev. Fred Nijem officiating. Mrs. Kirksey will be cremated and her cremated remains will be buried at Parrott Cemetery, Parrott, GA following the service. A native of Hanover, PA, Mrs. Kirksey had lived in Albany since 1957.
