



Anita J. Field Obituary

October 21, 1929 - November 5, 2007

Anita J. Field, 78, of Albany, died Monday at Evergreen Assisted Living. Her funeral service will be FRIDAY 10 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment following at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Finbarr Stanton will officiate. A native of Sparta, GA, she graduated high school from Holy Cross Academy and attended the University of Georgia. While at UGA, she met and married Patrick Field, who played football for the Bulldogs under Coach Wally Butts. She moved to Albany in 1951. Mrs. Field was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, a volunteer for Birthright, and Albany Community Hospice. She was a member of the Red Hats. Mrs. Field was food service manager at Darton College (then Albany Junior College) for 19 years from 1973-1992. She was preceded in death by her husband Pat Field and a daughter Donna Gail Field.
