Anne Durham Bragg, 87, of Albany died Thursday February 25, 2016, at Phoebe Sumter Medical Center in Americus, Georgia. She was born January 9, 1929 in Gallatin, Tennessee. Ms. Bragg was a graduate of Gallatin High School and received a BA degree in Psychology from Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee. She was married to the late William (Billy) R. Bragg of Albany.

She was a remarkable piano player and taught piano for many years. While an active member, at First United Methodist Church, she sang in the choir, belonged to the Fellowship Sunday School Class and served as a leader with the Methodist Women. She retired, after 30 years, as the RSVP Director at Southwest Georgia Council on Aging.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her son, Father Richard F. Bragg and her brother Walter T. Durham. She is survived by her daughter, Harriet Bragg Tate, a daughter-in-law, Jane T. Bragg, both of Albany; a sister-in-law, Anna C. Durham of Nashville, Tennessee; her grandchildren, Sarah Anne Tate, Elizabeth Jane Tate, Anna Thayer Bragg, Lisa Bragg and Scott Hill; two nieces and two nephews; and a special friend Marilyn Westbrook, with whom she worked with at Sowega Council on Aging.

A memorial service will be held in the sanctuary at First United Methodist Church, Albany at 12:00 Noon, on Saturday, March 5, 2016.
