



Anne Mercer Ellis Gardner

December 7, 1931 - September 1, 2024

Mrs. Virginia Anne Gardner, age 92, passed away on Sunday, September 1, 2024 at her longtime home in Putney, Georgia. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday, September 5, from 6:00 until 7:30pm and again on Friday morning at First Baptist Church of Putney at 10:00am. A Celebration of Life will be held Friday at First Baptist Church of Putney at 11:00am with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery.

A native of Jones County, Anne was the ninth of ten children born to the late Virgil and Annie Wiggins Mercer. She was first and foremost a child of the King and a longtime member of First Baptist Church of Putney where she served in various roles including singing in the choir, Happy Hearts Seniors, and teaching first and second grade Sunday School for more than thirty years. A prayer warrior, she touched many lives with her smile and testimony. Mrs. Gardner was a retired programmer with the Civil Service on the Marine Corps Logistics Base.

In addition to her parents, Anne was preceded in death by her husband of 43 years, Elijah M. Ellis, III; by her brothers Fred "Buddy" Mercer and David Mercer of Albany; sisters: Annie Ruth Mercer of Gray, Thelma Palmer of Pelham, Gladys Strange, Inez Barron, and Francis Adams all of Albany, and Betty Bryant of Americus.

Survivors include her husband of 28 years, Dr. H. Allan Gardner of Putney, two sons: Harvey (Marianne) Ellis of Jackson, GA and Mike (Angie) Ellis of Juliette, GA; five grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, her "baby" brother

Mack Mercer of Albany, GA and a whole lot of nieces and nephews. Mrs. Gardner is also survived by her sister-in-law Mary Gardner and her three bonus children: Stuart (Zoe) Gardner, Kellie (Adam) Strange, and Jennie Gardner and their families. 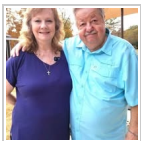
