### AnnEarl Jones Obituary

Mrs. AnnEarl Mull Jones, 77, died Monday, January 18, 2016 at Lee County Health Care in Leesburg, GA. Mrs. Jones will have a Funeral Service on Friday, January 22, 2016 at First United Methodist Church, Albany, GA in the Walden Chapel at 2 PM. Rev. Rebecca Rutherford and Dr. Donald M. Mrs. Jones was preceded in death by her husband of 53 years, Robert T. "Bobby" Jones; her parents, Louise Berry Mull and Earl "Pop" Mull and her brother, James A. "Smokey" Mull.

Mrs. Jones was born March 19, 1938 in Morganton, NC. She later moved to Albany, GA in 1944 where she lived throughout the rest of her life. Mrs. Jones was a graduate of Albany High School where she enjoyed playing in the band and ultimately became Head Majorette. She retired from GMAC after 30 years of service in finance. Mrs. Jones was a member of First United Methodist Church, Albany, GA for over 60 years, after she joined March 21, 1948. She served her church as a Sunday School teacher for many years and enjoyed playing the piano during those classes. She was a member of the Choir at First United Methodist, and a member of The Order of The Eastern Star. She also volunteered at the skating rink, where she supported and encouraged the kids in their competition skating. She was awarded "World's Best Skate Mom."

Mrs. Jones is survived by her children, Greg (Rita) Jones and Barbara (Ronnie) Bridges; her grandsons, Brandon Gage Wright, Joshua Wright, and Logan Wright; her nieces, Kelli Tennison, and Stacy (Thomas) Neal; her sister-in-law, Evonne S.
