Annette Maynard Hart of Elmodel died Friday, November 4, 2005 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. A native of Baker County, Mrs. Hart was living in Leesburg but lived in Elmodel most of her life. She was a member of Milford Baptist Church for over 60 years where she taught Sunday School. She attended several colleges and graduated from Valdosta State College with a Masters in Education. She taught school in Baker County for several years and retired as the director of the Baker County Department of Family and Children's Services. She was a member of the DAR, the Baker County Historical Society, the Georgia County Welfare Association, the DFCA Survivors, a former member of the Eastern Star and had served on the Board of Directors of the Baker County Mental Health. She was preceded in death by her husband, Charley Edwin Hart. Survivors include two daughters, Anne H. Pearlman of Leesburg, Jan H. Ford and her husband James of Lake Blackshier; two grandchildren, Christopher Dorsett and his wife Kellie of Decatur, Ivy Pearlman Shaffer and her husband Ron of Leesburg, 4 great grandchildren, Tyler Pearlman, Mason Sherman, Avery Shaffer, Matthew Shaffer a sister, Frona Hart and her husband Roy of Elmodel, a brother, Tom Maynard and his wife Margaret of Bainbridge and many nieces, nephews and cousins.
