



Anthony Joseph McMillan, Jr.

On Tuesday, March 18, 2025, Anthony McMillan, Jr. earned his wings and is now resting in the Heavenly Father's arms.

His funeral service will be at 12:00 PM on Tuesday, March 25, 2025 at Christian Life Missionary Baptist Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery with military honors. The Rev. Raymond Polite will officiate. The Buffalo Soldiers will provide an honorary escort. The family will receive friends prior to the service at the church beginning at 11 AM.

Anthony McMillan, Jr. was born August 13, 1963 in Fayetteville, NC. He was the oldest of 3 sons to Tony and Janet McMillan who preceded him in death along with his brother Gary McMillan and daughter Ramica Crawford. Anthony joined the United States Army after high school graduation. He served from Dec. 29, 1982 until Dec. 31, 2002 where he received an honorable discharge as an E7/SFC.

After retiring from the Army, Anthony worked with law enforcement in North Carolina. Anthony relocated to Albany, GA in 2011 and worked with Optempo, LLC. In 2018, Anthony worked for Defense Logistics Agency. He worked as an Equipment Specialist up until his passing.

Mr. McMillan was a proud member of the National Association of Buffalo

Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club and he had a resolution presented to him by Reginald "Road Runner" Marable, National Secretary.

Anthony leaves behind a loving wife: Camille McMillan; daughters: Keisha Broaden and Lashay Wright; sons: Charles Moss, Jr., Charles Moss, III, and Jared McMillan; brother: Gregg McMillan (Alice); grandchildren: Tamara Neal, Austin Moss, and Donavon Moss; several great grandchildren; aunts and uncles, and a host of nieces and nephews.
