June 17, 1940 - February 28, 2016

Antone (Tony) Daniel Lehr, died February 28, 2016 at Emory University Hospital in Atlanta. He was born June 17, 1940 in Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin to Frank and Dorothy Lehr.

His funeral Mass will be at 11:00 AM on Friday, March 4, 2016 at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with visitation at the church one hour prior to the Mass. The Rev. Ray Levreault will officiate. His burial service will be at Andersonville National Cemetery with full military honors following the funeral Mass.

Tony graduated from Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisconsin and received a Masters Degree in computer Informational Sciences from Georgia Tech. He retired as a Major in the United States Marine Corps and served three tours of duty in Vietnam. He was also the owner of Computer Showcase and was on the Board of Directors of Heritage Bank of the South (formerly AGE Credit Union) for thirty-five years.

Tony is survived by his wife of fifty-one years, Sue, of Albany; 2 daughters: Jennifer Brooks (Tom), Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and Kristin Etheredge (Billy) of Temple, Georgia; two granddaughters: Haven Brooks and Hollyn Brooks, both of Tuscaloosa, Alabama; 2 brothers: Tom Lehr (Helen), Sierra Vista, Arizona, Joe Lehr, Milwaukee, Wisconsin; several nieces and a nephew.
