Mr. Arthur E. Clark, 84, of Albany died July 11, 2007 at his residence. His funeral service will be 11 AM Friday at Kimbrell-Stern with interment in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. A native of Chattahoochee, FL, Mr. Clark resided in Albany for the last 58 years, moving here from Jacksonville, FL to open the office of Atlantic Loan Company where he was the manager for 30 years.
