



Arthur D. Fraser Obituary

Arthur D. (Art) Fraser, 64, of Albany, died Friday in Boston, MA, following an illness. His funeral service will be WEDNESDAY 12:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Revs. Bobby Moye and Cathy Green will officiate. A native of Lyons, GA, Mr. Fraser had lived in Albany since 1954. He was a graduate of Georgia Southwestern State University, and was a member of their alumni association. Mr. Fraser attended Palmyra United Methodist Church, and was a Navy veteran. He was employed with Merck and Co. for 30 years, retiring in 1993. Among his hobbies, Mr. Fraser enjoyed summers in the North Georgia Mountains, spending time with his grandchildren and his friends, selling crafts, and reading.
