Mrs. Mixon taught in the Dougherty County School System for 35 years and taught hundreds of children mostly in the 4 year old pre-K program. She was a member of the Albany Junior League, Past President and Past Chaplain of the American Legion Post 30 Auxiliary Unit, and Cabane 909 of the 40 & 8 Society. Mrs. Mixon raised 3 fine children.
