Ben F. Young, Sr., of Albany, died Sunday, October 8, 2006 at Palmyra Medical Center. The memorial service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday, October 11, 2006 at Beattie Road Church of Christ with Ministers Trey Poole, Jere Via and Jerry Whitmire officiating. A native of Elba, AL, Mr. Young was a member of Beattie Road Church of Christ where he was an elder, Sunday school teacher, and song leader. He was also an elder at Radium Springs Church of Christ and Director of Thailand Children's Home. Mr. Young was the owner/operator of Ben Young's Phillips 66 Service Center on Oglethorpe until his retirement in 1989 and a member of Georgia Association of Petroleum Retailers, and Woodmen of the World.
