



Mr. Bernard Clay Gardner III Obituary

January 13, 1957 - December 19, 2012

Bernard "Clay" Gardner III, 55, died Wednesday, December 19, 2012 in Columbus, Ga. Born in Albany, Georgia on January 13, 1957, Clay was the son of the late Henri Branch Whitaker Gardner and Bernard Clay "B.C." Gardner, Jr. He was a 1975 graduate of Deerfield High School. Mr. Gardner attended Valdosta State College, and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Communication. At Valdosta State, he was a member of the Kappa Alpha Fraternity. His passions in life included hunting, fishing, and time in the outdoors with his beloved dogs. A native of Albany, he moved to Columbus in 1999 to be closer to his family.

He is survived by his sister, Janet Kemp and her husband Robert of Columbus, Ga.; his nephew, Robert Colston Kemp of Columbus, Ga.; his niece, Martha Schley Whitaker Kemp of Richmond, Va.; his aunts, Mrs. Henry Wright (Martha) of Albany, Ga, and Mrs. Jay D.
