Mrs. Beth Banks, 70 of Albany died September 18, 2013 at Jack Hughston Memorial Hospital in Phenix City, AL.

A native of Macon, GA Mrs. Banks has lived in Albany since 1975. Mrs. Banks was a graduate of North Georgia College in 1964.

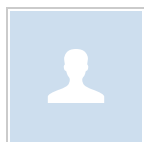
