Betsy Goolsby, 48, of Albany, died Saturday, May 27, 2006 at her residence. The memorial service will be held at 4 PM Tuesday at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church with Rev. Nathan Godley and Rev. Nancy Scarbrough officiating. A native of Ridgecrest, CA, Mrs. Goolsby had lived in Albany and Lee County for most of her life. She worked at Palmyra Medical Center as the Director of Human Resources, where she recently received her 30 year service pin. Mrs. Goolsby is a Senior Professional in Human Resources certified by the Society of Human Resources, a Past President of the Society of Human Resource Managers' Albany Chapter, and was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church.
