Betty Holt Pattison, born Elizabeth King Holt on September 12, 1938 in Atlanta Georgia passed away on March 6, 2022. She was the oldest daughter of Emmett P. and Mary K. Holt. Betty had a very interesting childhood moving to different parts of the south as her father was a freight procurer for the Seaboard Coastline Railroad. The family moved to Albany, GA in 1952, and Betty graduated from Albany High School in 1956. She was blessed to have many friends from school and church. After graduation she attended LaGrange College in LaGrange, GA, but a summer job with the City of Albany turned out to be secretarial career at the Public Works Department for 32 years. After giving retirement at home a try, she decided she needed more to do and became employed at her church, Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church as the secretary in the Music Department for approximately 25 years. She loved singing in the church choir and did so for many years. Work was her mainstay throughout her life.
