William T. "Bill" Lawing, 58, of Albany, died Sunday, October 9, 2005 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital following an illness. His funeral service will be WEDNESDAY, 11 AM at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Albany Police Department will present honors. A native of Anderson, SC, he attended schools there and graduated from McDuffie High School in 1965. Bill received his associates degree from Tri-County College in Pendleton, SC. He was a Navy Veteran of the Vietnam War. Bill served in the Albany Police Department from 1978 until his retirement in 2003. He was a member of the Oakwood Baptist Church in Anderson, SC, the Albany Fraternal Order of Police, a Mason, Moose Lodge, and the VFW. Bill was preceded in death by his parents, Laylon C. and Mary Frances Carter Lawing. Bill is survived by his wife: Tammy B. Lawing, Albany; a son: Ray Maples and his wife Lori, Edmond, OK; a daughter: Ginger Parsons and her husband Boulder, Leesburg, GA; 3 grandchildren: Logan Brooke Maples, Edmond, OK, Autumn Parsons, Stone Parsons, both of Leesburg.
