Bonnie Sue English, 67 of Albany, died Sunday, August 26, 2007 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday at Cool Springs Baptist Church in Colquitt County with the Rev. Ronald Barrett and Rev. Walter Burgess officiating. Interment will follow in Shady Grove Church Cemetery in Mitchell County. A native of Sale City, Mrs. English had lived in Albany for the past 43 years. She was a member of Cool Springs Baptist Church and the Senior Citizen Adult Sunday School Class. Mrs. English also helped in the rebuilding of Shady Grove Church and cemetery. She graduated from Sale City High School in 1957. Mrs. English went through the nursing program at Georgia Southwestern College and had been a registered nurse since 1960. She was active in the Phoebe Pioneers. Several years she received the Caring Hands Award, and was also recognized once with the Nurse of the Year Award. Mrs. English was a loving and caring mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She was preceded in death by her husband, Earl J. English; parents, William and Mamie Crosby; a sister, Kay Gay, and a brother, Wm. Lafayette Crosby. Mrs. English is survived by two daughters, Lucretia O'Hare and her husband David of Baconton, and Renee Rowe and her husband Bob of Sylvester; three sons, William E. English and his wife Rosemary of Leesburg, Barry M. English of Albany, and Bruce E.
