Bonnie Price Page, 90, of Albany, died Tuesday, May 25, 2021 at her home.

Her memorial service will be at 3 PM on Friday, May 28, 2021 at the graveside at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Grady Morey will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday from 6:00-7:30 PM.

Mrs. Page was born in Moultrie, GA and moved to Albany in 1950. Her parents were the late Barney B. Price and Minnie Bobo Price. She was a member of Westview Baptist Church. Mrs. Page was employed as the head bookkeeper at First State Bank, then was Trust Officer and Corporate Secretary for Security Bank and Trust. Following her retirement from Security Bank, she worked as bookkeeper for John Moulton until age 75. Bonnie accompanied her husband on military assignments to Far East AFB, Tokyo, Japan, Turner AFB, GA, Homestead AFB, FL, Chanute AFB, IL, and Keesler AFB, MS.

Mrs. Page is survived by her husband of 71 years CMSgt (Ret) Freddy Page, Albany; 3 daughters: Col (Ret) Terri Page, San Antonio, TX, Patti Holcomb (Larry), Leesburg, GA, Vicki Willmon (Floyd), Bossier City, LA; 2 grandchildren: Brad Page Willmon, Monroe, LA, Jenna Holcomb Peek (Cory), Leesburg, GA; 3 great grandchildren (Tristan, Tyler, and Tucker Peek).
