Dr. Brant Edgar Mayher, 41, of Simpsonville, SC, husband of Holli Whiting Mayher, died June 26, 2011. Born in Augusta, GA, he was a son of Dr. William Edgar Mayher, III and JoAnne Mullis Mayher of Albany, GA. Dr. Mayher was an Urologist at Palmetto-Greenville Urology. He was a 1987 graduate of Deerfield-Windsor High School in Albany, GA. He received his undergraduate degree in biology from the University of Georgia in Athens, GA, with cum laude and Phi Beta Kappa distinction. Dr. Mayher received his medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia School of Medicine in Augusta, GA. He completed his surgical internship and urology residency at The University of Tennessee at Memphis in Memphis, TN. He was a member of the Greenville Medical Society, American Medical Association, Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, American Urological Association, American Board of Urology, and SC Chapter of American College of Surgeons. Brant was a member of Christ Church Episcopal and the Holly Tree Tennis Club. He was an avid tennis player and Georgia Bulldogs fan. In addition to his wife and parents, he is survived by two children, Richmond and Pate Mayher; his brother, William "Bill" Mayher and his wife, Marnie, of Jacksonville, FL; and his sister, Anne Mayher of Greenville, SC.
