



## Mr. Brownie Byron Bass

Brownie Byron Bass, 60, of Albany, died Saturday, November 7, 2015 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral service will be at 11 AM on Tuesday, November 10, 2015 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Red Oak Cemetery. The Rev. Dan Story will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Tuesday morning beginning at 10 AM till the funeral hour.

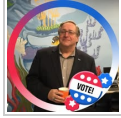
