



Bruce E. Grayson Obituary

May 20, 1917 - December 27, 2007

Mr. Bruce E. Grayson, 90, of Snellville, formerly of Albany, died December 27, 2007. His funeral service will be Saturday 2 PM at Crown Hill Mausoleum. Dr. William H. Sims officiating. Mr. Grayson was born May 20, 1917 in Magee, MS to William Eddie and Amanda Purvis Grayson and had lived in Albany for 50 years before moving to Snellville in the last part of his life. He joined the Army Air Corps in 1941 and served proudly and honorably for 25 years, retiring in 1966 at the rank of Senior Master Sergeant. He was a veteran of World War II in action in New Guinea, the Philippines and Okinawa. During the Korean War his unit the 31st Fighter Escort Wing of the Strategic Air Command made history by being the first air fighter wing to redeploy half way around the world to Japan from Turner AFB, GA using in-flight air refueling in an exercise code named Fox Peter One. He was a 32nd degree Mason of 54 years. Mr. Grayson was a member and deacon of Byne Memorial Baptist Church. Mr. Grayson was preceded in death by his wife of 52 years, Alyce Crosby Grayson and his brother Jerry Grayson. Mr. Grayson is survived by his sons Ed Grayson, Panama City, FL, Nick Grayson and his wife Gay Barrett Grayson, Lawrenceville; two granddaughters, Julie Cleveland and her husband Chris, Berkeley Lake and Cathy Thomason and her husband Keith, Owensboro, KY; three great grandsons, Kyle Cleveland and Sam Cleveland, Berkeley Lake and Grayson Thomason, Owensboro, KY; sisters Sara C. Easterling, Clinton, MS and Hilda Boone, Mendenhall, MS and a brother John B. Grayson, Simi Valley, CA. The family will receive friends Friday 6 to 8 PM at
