Byron Richard Rice, 82, of Albany, died Wednesday, May 7, 2008 at Northside Hospital in Atlanta. His funeral service will be MONDAY 3 PM at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Revs. Nathan Godley and Nancy Scarbrough will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Monday prior to the service from 1:30-2:30 PM. A native of Vero Beach, FL, Mr. Rice had lived in Albany since 1965. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church and served in the US Navy during WWII. Mr. Rice was in the dry cleaning business, co-owning and operating Snow White Laundry and 60 Minutes Dry Cleaners in Albany, and Modern Cleaners in Camilla, GA.
