



Mr. C. H. "Hap" Oliver, Jr. Obituary

Mr. Charles H. "Hap" Oliver, Jr., of Dawson died Friday, February 1, 2013 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. His funeral service will be Monday 11 AM at Cedar Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends Sunday 2 to 4 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Born in Americus, Mr. Oliver spent most of his life in Dawson. He was the owner and operator of Oliver Printing Company. He served in Pacific Theater with the 2nd Marine Division during World War II then served in the National Guard retiring with the rank of Major.

Mr. Oliver served as Magistrate Judge in Terrell County for 16 years and was a Scout Master with the Boy Scouts of America leading 7 scouts to the rank of Eagle Scout. He was a member of the Dawson United Methodist Church and an avid square dancer.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Charles H. and Elizabeth Holland Oliver, Sr., wife Celestee "Miss Tee" Oliver sisters, Betty Oliver Haynes and Reba Oliver Perkins.

Survivors include his son Howard Oliver and wife Becky, Dawson, daughter Jean Oliver Mackey, Lee County; grandsons, Chas Oliver and his wife Pati, Alpharetta, Justin Mackey, Lee County; great granddaughters, Peyton and
