Stanley Eugene (Gene) Callaway, 53 of Winter Springs, FL passed away in Orlando, FL, Monday after a lengthy illness. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors at 12 noon until 1:30 PM, Saturday, September 27, 2008 and graveside services will follow at 2 PM in Crown Hill Cemetery. Dr. Michael Helms of Trinity Baptist Church in Moultrie, GA will officiate. A native of Albany, Georgia, Gene graduated from Albany High School and the University of Florida in Gainesville. He lived and worked in the Gainesville and Orlando FL areas for the past 30 years. Gene loved people and valued his friends. He had fond memories of special friends from his younger days in Albany, from his experiences caddying at PGA and Senior PGA golf tournaments, as well as from his Gainesville and Orlando area years in the sales profession. He was an avid golfer, former member of Radium Springs Country Club, and a passionate Florida Gator fan. Gene cherished his family and the memories of his Byne Memorial Church family in Albany. He was preceded in death by his father and mother, Carl and Eileen Hayes Callaway of Albany.
