Canoy Estelle Roberson, 56 of Leesburg, GA died March 22, 2013 at Wynfield Park Nursing and Rehab in Albany.

A private memorial service was held Monday at Kimbrell-Stern. Mr. David Stern officiating.

A native of Albany, Canoy lived most of her life in Jacksonville, FL where she graduated from Jacksonville University in 1978 and was a Clinical Psychologist for over 20 years. She attended Deerfield-Windsor High School and received her Master's Degree from Valdosta State University in 1981.

Canoy converted into the Jewish Faith on September 7, 2001 and was a member of the Ahavath Chesed Congregation in Jacksonville, FL.

Canoy was preceded in death by her father, Dr. Phil E. Roberson and her grandparents, Phil E. and Canoy Roberson
