



Carl F. Leavy Obituary

Carl F. Leavy 79, of Albany, died Thursday, July 27, 2006 at his residence. His remains have been cremated and a memorial service will be 10 AM Saturday at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Rev. Mark Jones and Rev. John L. Jenkins will officiate. A private burial will follow at a later time. A native of Brunswick, Mr. Leavy has lived in Albany since 1961. He was a graduate of Glynn Academy of Brunswick and a graduate of Clemson University. He loved his family greatly and was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church for more than 45 years. He served his country proudly as a member of the United States Army during WWII. He was a former Dougherty County Administrator and a former City Manager of Albany. He was preceded in death by his parents Arthur Heyward and Mary Pauline Browne Leavy, and a sister Brownie L. Keleher. He is survived by his wife, Clarice Jones Leavy of Albany, 3 daughters: Claire Leavy of Leesburg, Cathy L. Whittington and her husband Curtis of Jacksonville FL, and Carol L. Cannon and her husband Mack of Macon; 4 grandchildren: Mary Catherine McNamee of St. George, FL, Christi Whittington Young and her husband Jason of Wesley Chapel FL, Arthur Carl Whittington of Tallahassee FL, and Christopher T.
