Carlton Law, 47, of Marietta, GA, formerly of Albany, died Tuesday, June 9, 2009 at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital, Marietta, GA. His funeral service will be MONDAY, June 15, 2009 at 11 AM at Holy Family Catholic Church, 3401 Lower Roswell Rd., Marietta, GA 30068. The family will receive friends beginning at 10 AM prior to the service at the church. An interment graveside service will be SATURDAY, June 20, 2009 at 10 AM at Crown Hill Cemetery 1907 Dawson Rd., Albany, GA 31707. The family will receive friends in Albany at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors on Friday, June 19, 2009 from 6-8 PM. Carlton was born in Baldwin County, Alabama. He attended schools in Albany, and graduated from Albany High School in 1980 where he ran track and specialized in distance running. He received a cross country scholarship from Appalachian State University in Boone, NC, where he received his undergraduate and a Master's Degree in Marketing.
