Mr. Carlton (Carl) Price, 83, of Albany died Saturday Sept 1, 2012 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral service will be held 10:00AM Tuesday at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Floral Memory Gardens. Dr. W.D. "Biff" Coker will be officiating. The family will receive friends Monday from 6:00 to 7:30PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Born in Elkhorn, WV, Mr. Price retired from the U.S. Navy as a Chief Petty Officer serving during WWII and Korea. He also retired from the Dept. of Transportation. Mr. Price was a member of Covenant Presbyterian Church, The Veterans of Foreign Wars, The American Legion, Loyal Order of the Moose and The Elks Lodge.

He was preceded in death by his wife Jacqueline Forringer Price.
