When she moved to Albany she joined Porterfield United Methodist Church (UMC) and began teaching second grade Sunday School. Her work for the UMW expanded into district level opportunities, and she provided her leadership skills for several boards including the Wesley Glen Ministries, Vashti and the City Missions Board, just to name a few. In the community, she worked for the Flint River Girl Scouts receiving the highest honor of the Girl Scouts, the Thanks Badge II award, for her work. She worked for the U.S. Census. She

She volunteered at Theatre Albany, Albany Hospice , Meals on Wheels, and the Albany Symphony. She was picked by WALB-TV as one of the Ten Who Make a difference. The Exchange Club of Albany awarded her the Golden Deeds award in 1999. Carol had so many talents and her greatest joy was in providing support, inspiration and unconditional love to everyone she encountered. As one close friend of hers said, "She must surely make God tired." She will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved her.
