Carol Slappey, 65, of Leesburg, died Monday, November 9, 2020 at her home. She was a beloved wife, mother, sister, daughter, and friend.

Her funeral service will be at 11 AM on Friday, November 13, 2020 at the graveside at Floral Memory Gardens. The Rev. Robert Greene will officiate. Social distancing guidelines will be followed. Mrs. Slappey will lie in state at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday, November 12, 2020 from 9 AM until 6 PM. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday, November 12, 2020 from 6-8 PM. Masks will be required for the family visitation and social distancing guidelines will be followed.

Mrs. Slappey was born in Knoxville, TN, then lived in Americus a short time, and lived most of her life in Albany and Lee County. She graduated from Albany High School. Mrs. Slappey had a 45 year banking career beginning with Home Federal Savings and Loan. She rose through the ranks as Home Federal became Georgia Federal, then AGE Credit Union, then Heritage Bank where she became Bank President. She retired from Renasant Bank in 2017

Mrs. Slappey attended Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church and was a faithful servant of the Lord. She was very active in many civic and professional organizations including Leadership Albany, Rotary Club, SOWEGA Council on Aging, and volunteered for Meals on Wheels and other

local food pantries and community organizations.

She was preceded in death by her father Benjamin Reese Wilson of Wrightsville, GA, her mother Angela Pickett of Jackson, Miss., her step son, John Mark Slappey of Lee County and her brother, Clay Wilson of Houston, TX.

Mrs. Slappey is survived by her husband of 41 years: Mark Slappey, Leesburg; 1 daughter: Jennifer Slappey, Leesburg; 1 step daughter: Heather Slappey Culpepper (Ernie), Lee County; 3 grandchildren: Camryn Culpepper, Morgan Culpepper, Sawyer Slappey Davis; sister: Sally Wilson Swift, Albany; brothers: Lee Wilson, Albany, Randall Wilson, Dallas, TX, and David Wilson, Macon, GA.

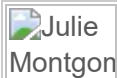
