Cecil Henry Ramsey Jr., of Leesburg, GA died Monday, September 15, 2014 after a brief illness at Willson Hospice House.

Cecil's memorial service will be 3 PM Friday, September 19, 2014 at Walden Chapel at the First United Methodist Church. Dr. Don Adams and Rev. Carl Barnhart will officiate.

Cecil was born November 27, 1930 in Atlanta. He was a past resident of Winter Springs, Sebastian, and Apollo Beach, FL until moving to Leesburg a few years ago.
