Charles D. (Sonny) Cox, 95, of Albany, died on Friday, October 20, 2023 at his home.

He will have a private, family only graveside service.

Sonny was born in Albany on July 5, 1928 to Charles D. Cox, Jr. and Kate Jordan Cox. He graduated from Newnan, GA, High School in 1945. He enlisted the U.S. Army Reserve and attended Clemson University until being called to active duty. He married Louise Powell in 1956 and lived in Jefferson, GA until moving back to Albany in 1960. He was employed with Georgia Printing Co. until joining the staff at First State Bank and Trust Co. in 1967 and retired as a Vice President in 1990. He was a past president of the Albany Kiwanis Club and past campaign chairman of the United Way of Dougherty County.
