Charles H. McGhee, 98, formerly of Albany, GA, died Friday, April 5, 2019 in Jacksonville, FL.

His funeral service will be at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, April 9, 2019 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery with military honors. The Rev. Dr. Butch Knight will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Tuesday prior to the funeral beginning at 10:00 AM until the funeral hour.

Mr. McGhee was born in Vinton, OH, and had lived in Albany since 1961. He was a longtime member of the First Baptist Church of Albany. Mr. McGhee was an Air Force pilot and veteran of WWII and Korea. Mr. McGhee was a prisoner of war during WWII. He retired with 21 years of service. He was a member of the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30, the Veteran of Foreign Wars, and the Golden K Kiwanis Club. Mr. McGhee was also a member of the Southwest Georgia Prisoner of War Chapter. He was preceded in death by his wife Ira Rouse McGhee.

Mr. McGhee is survived by a son: Donald Ray McGhee (Pam), Hamilton, GA; a daughter: Beverly Fletcher Davis (Bill), Jacksonville, FL; 3 grandchildren: Kathryn Fletcher, Jordan Fletcher, and Hannah McGhee; a brother: Robert McGhee, Worthington, OH; a sister: Bonnie Jones, Dallas, TX.
