



## Mr. Charles Inman Owens, Jr. Obituary

September 4, 1922 - May 9, 2013

Mr. Charles Inman Owens, Jr., 90, of Albany, died Thursday, May 9, 2012 at his home.

His funeral service will be Monday, May 13, 2013 at 2 PM at the First United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Dr. Don Kea, the Rev. Dr. Don Adams, and the Rev. Nancy Scarbrough will officiate. The family will receive friends on Monday in Ford Hall at First United Methodist Church at 1 PM until 2 PM.

Mr. Owens was born in Albany and graduated from Albany High School in 1940. He attended the University of Georgia. Mr. Owens served in the U.S. Army from 1942-1946. He went to work at the Bank of Albany in 1951, and retired from C & S Bank in 1980. Mr. Owens was a lifelong member of the First United Methodist Church, and served as a Steward for several years. He was a longtime member of the Exchange Club of Albany where he served as Treasurer of the Exchange Club Fair of Southwest Georgia, Inc. for many years. In 2010, he was honored for numerous positions held in the Exchange Club, and for his dedicated service. Mr. Owens loved Tennessee Walking Horses, and he rode for pleasure and showed them.

He is survived by his wife of 68 years: Lorene Harris Owens, Albany; a daughter: Susan Owens Greene and her husband Phil, Albany; grandchildren:

Cathie Knight Chandler and her husband Chad, Albany, Harrison Greene, Albany, Phillip Greene and his wife Holly, California; great grandchildren: Collins Chandler, Carson Chandler, and Kiran Greene.
