Mr. Charles E. Walker, 101, died Tuesday, February 25, 2014 at the Willson Hospice House.

His funeral service will be Friday 2 PM at First Baptist Church of Albany with entombment at Crown Hill Mausoleum. Dr. Butch Knight will officiate. The family will receive friends Thursday 5 to 7 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Mr. Walker was born in Americus, GA, the youngest son of Henry S. Walker and Valencia Davenport Walker. He had lived in Albany since 1951 and worked for Southern Bell Telephone for 43 years, retiring in 1977. A faithful member of First Baptist Albany since 1953 Mr. Walker was a member of the Adult 1 Sunday School, a deacon, served on many committees and taught youth Sunday School. He was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America and served as President of the local chapter.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years Nell B. Walker.

Survivors include his sons, Charles E. Walker, Jr. and his wife Donna, Brunswick, GA; Patrick B Walker and his wife Tricia, Stone Mountain, GA; daughter Fran Zolomy and her husband Jack, Albany, GA; grandchildren, Betsy Rhoton and her husband Billy, Bristol, VA, Sarah Coe and her husband Todd, Senoia, GA, Jill King and her husband Davis, Sylvester; great grandchildren, Maggie Coe, Toby Coe, Trey Rhoton, Logan Rhoton.
