



Charlye Ruth Sasser Obituary

Charlye Ruth Arnold Sasser 89, of Albany died Monday at her residence. A graveside service will be held Monday, November 19, 2007 at 2 PM in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Michael A. McAfee will officiate. A native of Doerun, Mrs. Sasser lived in Albany most of her life. She was a graduate of Ty Ty High School; Freeman Business College and Albany Junior College School of Nursing. In high school she was a member of the basket ball team and was salutatorian of her class. She was a member of the YMCA, the Ladies Golf Association, Doublegate Country Club, and the Radium Country Club. She was president of the Flint River Girl Scout Council from 1967 to 1969 and was involved with the acquisition of Kara Gheusian-in-the-Pines and Okitayankani. She was a past member of Ty Ty Baptist Church, Central Baptist Church and was a member of the S.C. Walden Sunday school class at First Baptist Church of Albany. She retired from Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital following several years of service. She was preceded in death by her husband, Roff Hinton Sasser Jr.. She is survived by 4 daughters: Ruth Sasser Garrison and her husband William B. Garrison Sr. of Tallahassee FL; Martha Sasser Joiner and her husband G. Hewett Joiner Jr. of Statesboro; Claire Sasser Banister of Albany; and Barbara Sasser Livingston of Gray; her son: Roff Hinton Sasser III and his wife Paulette of Swainsboro; 13 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren; and sister-in-law, Martha Sasser Pitts of Cordele; and a host of nieces, nephews and close friends.
