Mr. Clifford Graham, Sr. 93, of Lee Dr. in Leesburg, GA died November 14, 2014 at his residence.

Funeral services will be Monday 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern. Mr. Graham's son, Eschol Graham, Jr. will officiate. Interment will follow in Floral Memory Gardens Cemetery with military honors.
