Cora Jean Hepner Lingle, 92 of Albany, died Monday, May 23, 2005 at the Magnolia Manor Nursing Center in Americus, GA. Her remains have been cremated and a memorial service will be held at 11 AM Friday, May 27, 2005 at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. Rev. Nathan Godley and Rev. Nancy Scarbrough will officiate. She will be interred in Caney, KS at a later date. She was born Nov. 29, 1912 in Washington Co., Oklahoma, the daughter of the late Art and Phoebe Hepner.
