CPO Arnold F. Soley, Jr. USN (Ret.) 78, died Saturday, August 2, 2014 at Willson Hospice House.

Funeral services will be held, Wednesday, August 6, 2014 at 10:00AM at Kimbrell-Stern. Visitation will be held Tuesday, August 5, 2014 from 7:00PM until 9:00PM at Kimbrell-Stern.
