



## Curtis T. McGee Obituary

April 15, 1917 - November 2, 2007

Curtis T. McGee, 90, of Albany, died Friday, November 2, 2007 at his home following an illness. His funeral service will be MONDAY 2 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with entombment to follow at Crown Hill Mausoleum with full military honors. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Monday from 1 PM until the funeral hour. A native of Irwinville, GA, Mr. McGee moved to Albany at his retirement in 1977. He was a 26 year Marine Corps veteran serving in World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. He retired with the rank of Master Sergeant. He was stationed in Japan, Korea, and Vietnam, along with posts in South Carolina, North Carolina, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, and California. Following his retirement from the Marines in 1966, he worked with the US Postal Service for 10 years in Vista, California, then retired to Albany. He was a Baptist, and was a member of the Fleet Reserve Association, and the Disabled American Veterans. He was preceded in death by his parents Dave and Ida Roberts McGee. He is survived by his wife of 64 years: Elizabeth C. McGee, Albany; a son: Curtis T. McGee, Jr. and his wife Terrie, Albany; a daughter: Beth M. Shepherd and her husband Tim, Griffin, GA; 7 grandchildren: April Thompson and her husband Eddie, Albany, Derek McGee and his wife Diana, Springfield, MO, Lelanea McGee, Phoenix, AZ, Salina Widgeon and her husband Dennis, Alabama, Patrick Shepherd, Eric Shepherd, Alec Shepherd, all of Griffin; 7 great-grandchildren; a brother: W.
