



Daisy P. Holden Obituary

November 10, 1919 - October 2, 2008

Daisy Paracca Holden, 88, of Albany, died Thursday, Oct. 2, 2008, at Palmyra Park Hospital. The funeral service will be held at 4 PM Saturday at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with Rev. Tony Haefs officiating. Entombment will follow at Crown Hill Mausoleum. A native of Humboldt, TN, Mrs. Holden had lived in Albany since 1957. She was a member of the First Baptist Church, where she was active in the Library and Flower Ministry. She was a dedicated wife, mother, and grandmother. She was preceded in death by her husband John W. (Jack) Holden, Sr., in 1981, and her beloved dog Gretchen in 2007.
